## 2. Examples of tasks to assess the development of practical skills.

1. Formation of a diagnosis and determination of tactics for the management of surgical patients at the hospital stage (according to the work practice diary).
2. Determination of pulsation of peripheral arteries of the lower extremities: femoral, popliteal, arteries of the leg and foot.
3. Apply a hemostatic tourniquet to the thigh if there is bleeding from the femoral artery.
4. Technique for digital examination of the external inguinal ring and interpretation of the results.
5. Catheterization of the bladder with rubber and metal catheters. Indications. Technique. Complications and ways to prevent them.
