

## МОДАЛЬНЫЕ ГЛАГОЛЫ

Модальные глаголы в английском языке отличаются от остальных глаголов тем, что они не используются самостоятельно и не обозначают конкретного действия или состояния, они отражают его модальность, то есть отношение к нему говорящего.

1) Вопросительные предложения с модальными глаголами образуются без вспомогательного глагола, при этом модальный глагол выносится в начало предложения

2) Отрицательная форма модального глагола образуется постановкой после него частицы *not*.

3) После модальных глаголов, кроме глагола *ought to* следует инфинитив без частицы *to*.

### CAN = be able to

### MAY = be allowed to

	<b>am/is/are allowed to</b> Children <i>are allowed to</i> walk till 9 p.m.	<b>was/were allowed to</b> I <i>was allowed to stay up late</i> on the weekends when I was a child.	<b>will be allowed to</b> Once they turn 18, they <i>will be allowed to vote</i> in the upcoming elections.
+	You <i>may do</i> this job tomorrow.	The weather <i>might be</i> better tomorrow. (Present, Future) They <i>were allowed to stay</i> .	They <i>will be allowed to stay</i> .

### MUST = have to

You <i>must listen</i> to the teacher. I <i>must go</i> now. It's too late. He <i>must be</i> at home now.</p>	-----	-----
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- вынужденная необходимость, долженствование, вытекающие из определенных обстоятельств</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>have to/has to</b></p> <p>We <i>have to return</i> the books to the library on time to avoid late fees.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>had to</b></p> <p>I <i>had to stay late</i> at work to finish the project.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>will have to</b></p> <p>I <i>will have to attend</i> a meeting tomorrow afternoon.</p>
+	I <i>must do</i> it today, I can't leave it till tomorrow.	He <i>had to do</i> it.	He <i>will have to do</i> it.

	I/we/you/they <b>have to go</b> there. He/she/it <b>has to go</b> there.

### SHOULD

Значение	Present	Past	Future
выражает моральную обязанность, долг или совет	<b>should</b> You <b>should eat</b> a balanced diet for optimal health. He <b>should be punctual</b> for the meeting.	-----	-----
+	You <b>should see</b> a doctor.		
?	What <b>should I do</b> now?		
-	You <b>should not be late</b> for the classes.
