Degree	Time to Complete	Who Should Get This Degree?	Career Paths
Associate	2 years	Anyone who wants to join the workforce in an entry- level position (typically non-managerial) or transfer into a full, undergraduate bachelor's program	Administrative assistant, medical billing and coding specialist, health office receptionist, medical transcriptionist
Bachelor's	4 years	Those wanting an entry level healthcare management and administration (according to the BLS, the minimum degree required for management positions)	Private-practice office manager, healthcare consultant, medical reimbursement specialist, healthcare human resources manager
Master's	2–3 years	Working professionals seeking career advancement or students who hold a bachelor's degree but want to enter the field at a higher level	Director, administrator, or practice manager for a range of settings and industries, including insurance providers, hospitals, mental health organizations, government entities, and home healthcare organizations
Doctorate	3–5 years	Top-level administrators who want to manage entire facilities, steer policy, or conduct research	Hospital CEO, nursing home director, clinical manager, health information manager, as well as top positions in the nonprofit sector or in government conducting research or crafting policy
