A degree in healthcare management prepares graduates for leadership roles in healthcare industry. Although hospitals remain the leading employers of healthcare managers, a variety of other companies also hire graduates with a degree in health management.

A lot of professionals in healthcare management work in hospitals, outpatient clinics or other healthcare facilities. Their main function is to ensure that these facilities run efficiently and provide effective care. In clinical settings, healthcare managers may manage one division or department or may be in charge of the entire facility, depending on the size of the organization, the number of employees and their level of experise.

After hospitals, nursing homes and home health services are the next leading employers of healthcare management professionals. In nursing homes, healthcare managers supervise the staff, oversee admission and manage finances. Home health services companies hire healthcare managers to oversee operations and finances and to hire and supervise staff.

There is also a need for healthcare managers in a number of settings beyond clinical settings. Insurance companies hire healthcare management graduates to research, assess and analyze the costs of providing healthcare, and to propose strategies and policies for ensuring that the company remains both profitable and competitive.

Some healthcare managers may seek employment with state or federal agencies such as the Center for Disease Control and the Food and Drug Administration, or with national organizations such as the Red Cross or the American Hospital Association. These types of organizations need professionals who can analyze health legislation and policy, plan and organize health programs, and direct departments within the organization. In these types of positions, healthcare managers may have the opportunity to help shape important healthcare policies in a country.
