## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOING INDEPENDENT WORK

Independent work by students is carried out and presented to the teacher in full-time during the cycle of seminars. Independent work of students includes independent study of three separate topics provided for in the work program, and presentation of the work in one of the selected ways, at the discretion of the student:

## The first execution option.

- 1. Students' independent work consists in writing (by hand) a 5-sheet answer for every two hours of independent work.
- 2. The work should have a title in accordance with the chosen topic and an indication of the full name and group number of the student who completed the work.

### The second execution option.

- 1. A separate presentation is being prepared for each topic of independent work.
- 2. Each presentation is made by the student individually.
- 3. The number of slides in the presentation is based on 5 semantic slides per 1 hour. The first slide with information about the authors is not taken into account.
- 4. The first slide indicates the topic of the work, full name and group number of the student who completed the work.
- 5. The slide should contain no more than 5-6 lines of text (font-14-18).
- 6. No more than 50% of the slides should have pictures or tables illustrating the material under consideration.

# CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING INDEPENDENT WORK

Each topic of independent work is rated from 3 to 5 points, work rated below 3 points is not counted and requires completion by the student.
